

**WORLD CULTURES HONORS  
SUMMER PROJECT  
2015 - 2016  
“NEWS AND CURRENT EVENTS”**

Collect 35 newspaper articles, 10 of which must come from the three major sections of any local or national newspaper: Front section, local and nation, or Business. Other sections of the paper may be used to complete the remaining 25.

You do not have to use the Reading newspaper, any local, regional, or city newspaper will be fine.

Organize like this:

- 1) Title Page - your name, title of the project, and course.
- 2) List of Articles - numbered list of your article titles in the order they appear.
- 3) Articles -
  1. Mount each one on a separate page and label it.
  2. No photocopied or internet articles.
  3. Articles must be at least 20 sentences in length.
  4. Articles must be from June 2014 through August 2014.
- 4) Summary - With each article will be a summary of the article (5-10 sentences). This must be typed and can be on the same page as the article or on back.
- 5) Conclusion - A well constructed essay of 3 pages, 1.5 spaced, 12 point font. Tell me what you learned.
  - Put some thought into it - if you do not, I will grade accordingly.
  - Some ideas for your conclusion:
  - What have you learned about the nature of:
    - our society, politics, conflict, economics, crime, foreign relations, science, medicine, energy, business, the military, etc.
    - How has your awareness/outlook changed?
    - Change in your view of your neighborhood, city, state, country, or the world in general.

Remember that giving examples is fine, but the conclusion is not simply to re-state the information, but to reflect upon the local, national, and global nature of the things you have read and the effect on your outlook.
